Due to high combined filter effluent turbidity in the water system and the potential for

contamination as a result of this situation, the drinking water supplied by Copan PWA may be

unsafe for human consumption. As a precaution, it is advised that the consumers of this water

system bring the water to a full, rolling boil for at least one minute before drinking,

consumption, food preparation, baby formula preparation, dish washing, tooth brushing, ice

making, wound care, and bathing infants who may ingest bath water. Alternatively, bottled

water or another acceptable water source may be used.

Comments: This is due to a mechanical failure with the equipment at the water treatment plant. We have taken all the necessary measures to resolve and repair the failures. We should be in

the perimeter of safe turbidity soon. We have made contact with the State DEO offices and are

following their advice during this time.
