\$36.7 million with no millage increase:

- Reconfigure BHS to grades 9-12 with additional classrooms, Freshman Academy, commons, etc.
- Expanding and renovating Central Middle School
- Shift Madison Middle School students to the adjacent Mid-High
- Security upgrades district-wide
- Secondary Technology updates
- Furnishings district-wide

2016: Small Change, Big Difference

\$17.5 million for Operations/Facilities: 4,056 YES & 1,767 NO= 70% YES

\$2 million for Transportation: 4,233 YES & 1,601 NO = 73% YES

\$17.5 million over a five-year period for:

- Operational Funding: Saving Jobs & Preserving Class Sizes
- Facility Projects: Instructional Technology, Equipment, and Facilities
 - Reconfigure and renovate facilities for extracurricular activities at Madison Middle School and Bartlesville High School
 - Renovations at Madison Middle School and to renovate the auditorium at Central Middle School
 - Safety upgrades at the six elementary school playgrounds
 - Renovations at Hoover and Jane Phillips

\$16.1 million for Operations/Facilities: 2,597 YES & 615 NO= 81% YES \$1.85 million for Transportation: 2,652 YES & 561 NO = 83% YES

\$17.915 million over a five-year period (ending in FY23) for:

- Operational Funding: Saving Jobs & Preserving Class Sizes
- Technology: Extend the districtwide Chromebooks initiative
- STEM/Vo-Ag: Build a classroom shop for the vocational program and refresh
 K-12 STEM devices and equipment
- Maintenance and Facility Projects: Replace climate control systems and elevators that are over 50 years old, along with other maintenance needs in facilities which were 36-103 years old. Replaced the 65-year-old pressbox.
- Safety: Extend past safety enhancements, including more cameras and safer pedestrian crossings.
- Transportation: Replaced all buses that are over a decade old.

2019 BOND ISSUE SUMMARY

Voters approved \$17,915,000 for projects that include:

Next Bond Election

- Passage will NOT INCREASE THE TAX RATE
- Annual funding for operations
- Internal requests
- Agriculture Center
- Election Dates (resolution due 60 days before election)
 - 2021 = Special election date options each month. Targeting the August 10 date for the election and the May 17, 2021 school board meeting to consider the resolution.
 - 2022 = Elections are prohibited by state law in May, July, September,
 October, and December in even-numbered years.
